1. Why do you want to work at Volkswagen?

Answer: "I have always been passionate about cars, so I am excited to work for such an innovative company. In my previous role as a sales associate, I learned more about the different models available from Volkswagen and fell in love with the brand. Working here would allow me to continue learning about new vehicles while also helping customers find the right car for their needs."

2. Tell me about a time when you had to deal with an angry customer, how did you handle it?

If there isn't anything I can do about the situation, I will offer them an alternative solution."

4. What is your favorite car of ours and why?

Answer: "I am a huge fan of the Volkswagen Golf GTI, as it's one of my favorite cars I've ever driven. The car handles well, has plenty of power and looks sporty but not too flashy. I love how it can be customized so many different ways, making it unique to each driver."

5. What is a recent trend that has caught your attention in the automotive industry?

Answer: "I've noticed that more consumers are turning to online resources for information about their vehicles, which has led to a rise in digital marketing

strategies from automotive companies. I think this trend could be beneficial for VWFS because it would allow us to reach new customers who may not have heard of our company before."

6. What do you think makes Volkswagen stand out against other automakers?

Answer: "Volkswagen stands out because of its commitment to innovation. The company is always looking at new ways to improve its vehicles and customer experience.
