**Title of the activity:** International Yoga Day

**Date:** 21st June 2019

**Collaborating Agency:** NSS Wing of Dronacharya Group of Institutions, Greater Noida associated with Sidhyog Ashram and AICTE

**Number of Participants:** 150

### **Brief of the Event:**

**Collaborating Agency: Sidhyog Ashram**

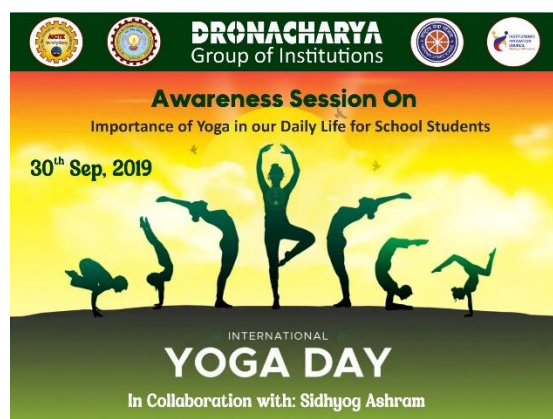
**Number of Participants: 150**

**Date:** 4<sup>th</sup> March, 2020

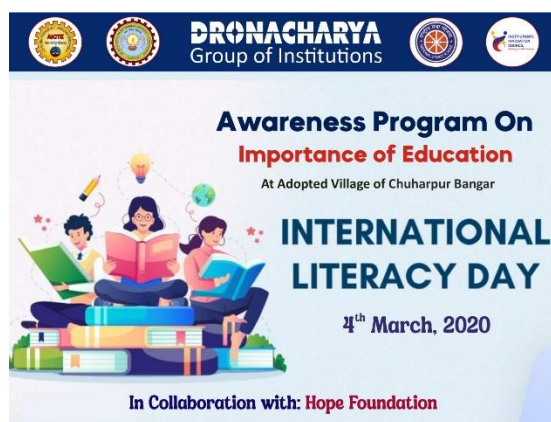
**Collaborating Agency:** Hope Foundation
